

NCAA Dress Code

Our dress code has been created with the idea of promoting a positive learning atmosphere and a wholesome attitude for each and every student.

Safety, neatness, cleanliness, consistency, decorum and common decency are the guiding standards for all student dress.

A student's style of dress and/or grooming may reflect individual preference; however, such preferences must be selected within the constraints of reasonable rules and appropriate standards that are consistent with the maintenance of an effective learning atmosphere and good personal hygiene.

KINDERGARTEN

Girls must wear V-neck Pleated Plaid Jumper with blue knit shirts

Boys must wear navy blue pants with blue knit shirts.

Grades 1 – 6

Girls must wear V-neck Pleated Plaid Jumper with Yellow oxford shirts.

Boys must wear Khaki pants with yellow oxford shirts

Grades 7 - 12

MONDAY – THURSDAY: Students are required to wear plaid dress shirts (male & female); any color will be acceptable but no more than two buttons may be open; A blazer, sweater cardigan or vest must be worn over plaid shirt daily.

Girls must wear black dress pants or skirts (must be knee length).

Boys must wear dress pants (must have a zipper or button closure at the waist. No athletic, sport, recreational, or lounge pants are allowed.

FRIDAY CHAPEL: Girls must wear a skirt and boys must wear a tie.

All Students

RECREATIONAL: NCAA t-shirts must be worn for P.E. Each class will make their own policy regarding special occasions or field trips. NCAA pullover hoodies or sweatshirts are allowed. All other hoodies must be of a solid color and zippered so that the plaid shirt shows.

HAIR/JEWELRY/TATTOES/

MAKE-UP: Hair must be a natural color and off the shoulders. Boys: No dreads Girls: All hair extensions must be pulled back from face. Make-up and nail polish must look natural. NO TATTOES or JEWELRY
